Many pastors find it hard to preach on Trinity Sunday. It isn't easy to explain one of Christianity's greatest mysteries in 20 minutes without committing heresy at least once.

The Trinity might sound like a topic only for theology students, but it actually tells us something important and beautiful about who God is. The Trinity shows us a God who is dynamic and relational—less like a fixed object and more like an ongoing action.

Thinking of God as three Persons helps us picture God as a continuous, overflowing exchange of love. And here's the good news: because God became like us in Christ Jesus, we are invited to participate in that exchange. God's love isn't self-contained, it reaches out to include all of us and all Creation.

If that raises more questions than answers, that's exactly what Sunday's service is for! I hope you'll join us, whether in person or online.

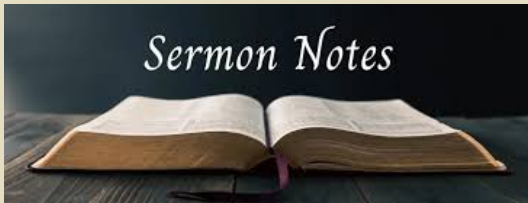

Thank you to all who helped support us donating 48 hygiene kits this year to UMCOR.



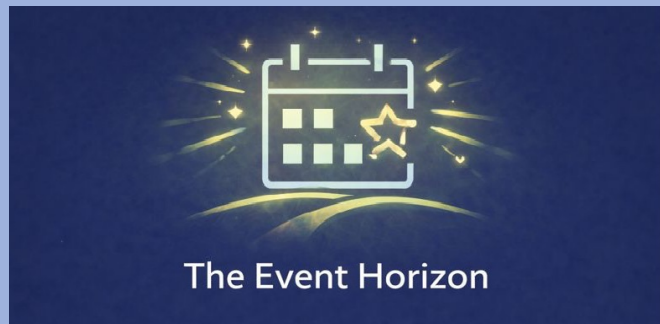
